Entry Fees: \$52.50 per run (\$50 + \$2.50 GST)

Sniff N' Go style event. Teams will be assigned a timeslot and should arrive prior to their time to prepare their dog. Teams not present at their scheduled time may forfeit their entry. There will be no walkthrough.

3 Time Slots:

Morning: 9:00am – 11:30am **Early Afternoon:** 12:00pm – 2:30pm **Late Afternoon:** 3:00pm – 5:30pm

Competitors may choose a time slot preference at the time of entry. Efforts will be made to accommodate preferences, however, no guarantees can be made and teams should be available to attend at any time throughout the event day. Final schedule will be sent on or before Monday December 20.

- Open to all dogs of any breed including mixes.
- All Handlers and Dogs Welcome!
- “For Exhibition Only” (FEO) may enter but will receive no score or placement.
- This trial is indoors on vinyl flooring.
- Crating in vehicles only.
- Participants are responsible for keeping dogs safe and comfortable in vehicles.

How It Works:

Teams have **5 minutes** to find an unknown number of hides (1 - 10) & call “Finish”.

100 boxes will be arranged in 4 rows of 25 and secured to the ground with tape & numbered.

Handler will call alert by calling out box number. Odors used will be **Birch, Anise, & Clove**. Some boxes may contain toy or food distractors.

Placements will be awarded based on overall score.

SCORING

+10 points correct find

+10 points correct “Finish”
(all hides found when “Finish” is called)

-5 points incorrect find – first time

-10 points incorrect find – second time

-2 points dropped food

-5 points disrupted box
(excessive pawing, nosing, stepping on)

NQs:

3rd incorrect find

Eliminating in search area

Destroyed box
(box crushed, chewed, etc)

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 ranking teams plus special prizes will also be available.

1st place: \$400

2nd place: \$200

3rd place: \$100

Special Prizes:

0 False Alerts:

All dogs with 0 false alerts will be entered in a prize draw and a name will be drawn.

Exceptional Team:

A team that displays great teamwork and overall positivity.

Delivery of prizes:

Monetary prizes will be delivered via e-transfer. Special prizes may require pick-up from Extraordinary Canines Inc.

Results:

Results will be emailed within 48 hours of the completion of the event to the email address provided at time of entry. Dog's name and first name of handler will also be announced on social media.

Notice to Exhibitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules set forth in this premium including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry.

All exhibitors are expected to treat the judge, trial hosts, your canine partner and all other exhibitors with respect. All judges and trial hosts are expected to show respect to all exhibitors.

This trial is open to all dogs trained in sporting scent detection (using birch, clove, & anise oils).

A second dog with the same handler is not eligible to compete. The same dog handled by a different handler is also not eligible to compete. Second entries of dogs or handlers will be accepted as **FOR EXHIBITION/ENJOYMENT ONLY** (“FEO”). Dogs running FEO will be run at the end of the day and will receive no score or placement.

Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner’s immediate family.

Collars: The dog must wear a flat type collar (buckle, snap or proper fit martingale) and/or body harness in the ring. *Electronic training collars and prong/pinch collars are not allowed on the show grounds. Teams with this equipment will be dismissed.*

Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.

Handlers, through entry at the event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.

In addition, the organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.

THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND for entries in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal.

Registration shall be completed online. Payment of entry fees shall be made by e-transfer after entry has been approved. Any fees not received within **72 hours** of notice will result in cancellation of entry.

Refunds will not be offered to entrants that withdraw unless the spot is able to be filled from the waitlist. Changes to your entry may incur a \$10 administration fee.

All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes.

Dogs must be on leash while on the show grounds except within the designated search area. Dogs must be leashed upon entering and exiting the search area.

This event is open to dogs that may be reactive to other dogs. As such, participants are asked to maintain a minimum of 10 feet between dogs at all times (much greater space is encouraged). There is no dog-to-dog contact permitted on show grounds, excluding dogs from the same household.

Dogs with a history of aggression are not eligible to enter. Dogs that show aggressive behaviour may be dismissed from show grounds.
