## Eligibility:

Please see the Super Scenter League rulebook for full information on eligibility for SSL. Please see the Canine Work and Games rulebook for full information on eligibility for C-WAGS. Teams must be registered to earn qualifying scores and titles in the respective organization.

Dog-reactive dogs are permitted at this event. Human reactive dogs are not appropriate for this event.

## Entry Fees & Dates

**SSL Entry Fee:** \$20 + GST (\$21.00) per skill entered

**C-WAGS Entry Fee:** \$22 + GST (\$23.10) per run entered

**Entries Open:** Sunday, February 25 at 8:00am (pacific)

**Lottery Draw:** Tuesday, February 27 at 8:00am (pacific)

**Entries Close:** Saturday, March 16 at 11:59pm (pacific)

## Entries Process:

Entries will be accepted through K9TrialHub.

SSL & C-WAGS entries will be accepted separately.

## Entries System



Participants will need an account on K9TrialHub and the dog(s) they wish to enter must be added to their account before they are able to enter an event/trial.

Entries are limited. A lottery system will be used to accept entries received by 8:00am on February 27. If space is still available after the lottery draw then acceptance of entries will be on a first-come first-served basis.

Entrants will be able to view their entry status when logged into K9TrialHub including the amount of any entry fees owing (“My Entries” page).

**Entry fees are due when the entry status is marked as “pending payment” within K9TrialHub.** Fees are due within 72 hours of being marked as “pending payment”. Entry fees may be e-transferred to [megan@extraordinarycanines.com](mailto:megan@extraordinarycanines.com). If required, the password used shall be ‘SuperScenter’.

**It is the participants responsibility to monitor their entry status at least once every 72 hours.** Before withdrawing a participant for non-payment, the host will send a final notice email and may withdraw your entry if payment has not been received within 24 hours of that notice.

### **K9TrialHub Entry Status Guide:**

- “Pending” – Your entry has not yet been processed by the host
- “Pending Payment” – Your entry is accepted and will be approved following the receipt of your payment of the amount owing shown on the “My Entries” page.
- “Approved” – Your payment has been received and processed by the host and you will receive trial details approximately 1 week prior to the trial. Note that it may take up to 48 hours to see your entry status updated from “pending payment” to “approved”.
- “Waitlisted” – You have been added to the waitlist and the host will contact you via email if space becomes available.

## **Final Event/Trial Details**

Final details will be emailed to participants 5 - 7 days prior to the event/trial.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Participants, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of rules and regulations set forth in the rulebook(s) of the respective organization(s) they have entered under including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:
- All exhibitors are expected to treat the judges, trial hosts, their canine partner, and all other exhibitors with respect. All judges and trial hosts are expected to show respect to all exhibitors.
- To earn qualifying results teams must be registered with the governing organization (SSL or C-WAGS). Entries of non-registered dogs will be accepted as “FEO”.
- Dogs must be handled by a member of the registered handler’s immediate family.
- Collars: The dog must wear a flat type collar (eg. buckle/snap) and/or body harness in the ring. Electronic training collars and prong/pinch collars are not allowed on the show grounds.
- Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the search area must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- Handlers, through entry at the event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- The trial host/organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- **THERE SHALL BE NO REFUND** for entries in the event a dog and/or handler is dismissed from the trial, regardless of reason for such dismissal.
- Registration shall be completed online. Payment of entry fees shall be made by e-transfer after entry has been approved.
- **Refunds will NOT be offered** to entrants that withdraw unless their spot is able to be filled from the waitlist. Changes to your entry, including withdrawal, will incur a \$15 administration fee.
- Move-ups will not be offered.
- All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of the C-WAGS event for their personal use only. No videography is permitted for SSL. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes.
- Dogs must be on leash while on the show grounds unless in the ring.
- Dogs must remain inside their vehicle at all times unless they are being toileted, staging, searching, or on their way to or from the aforementioned activities.
- This event is open to dogs that may be reactive to other dogs. Participants are asked to maintain a minimum of 15 feet between dogs at all times (greater space is encouraged).
- There is no dog-to-dog contact permitted on show grounds, excluding dogs from the same household.
- Dogs with a history of aggression are not eligible to enter. Dogs that show aggressive behaviour may be dismissed from show grounds.
